Main Street Beatrice will be hosting its ninth-annual Taste of Spring event Saturday at The Kensington Ballroom.

Taste of Spring will begin at 6 p.m. and lasts for around two hours.

The event will consist of a wine tasting with light hors d'uvres being served as well.

There will be six wines available to sample, including Montes Carmenera, a red wine from Chile. Other wines at Taste of Spring come from California, Germany, Holland and Italy.

There will also be an assortment of ales available, for those who don't

fancy wine.

Hors d'uvres at the event will consist of cheese, fruit trays and breads with dipping sauces.

Some of the money raised by Taste of Spring in the past has gone towards things like planters and lights, according to Alexis Winder, Executive Director of Main Street Beatrice.

"Taste of Spring is an annual fund raiser that we do. It helps us raise money that is directly used in the downtown community."
